#### 1 good structure

- This course is great. Topics in the course are very interesting and presented in a way that sparks curiosity. The only issue that I had in the course was that certain grades, including the final, are dependent on other students. In fact, actions could be taken do directly impact the grades of other students. For this reason, students are incentivized to directly compete with each other and essentially "fight for their lives".
- 3 This course felt rushed towards the end, but this is the first time this couse was taught so that's forgivable.
- There should be fewer obstacles for learning in this class. No assignment should have riddles to figure out what the actual tasks are. I struggled through most assignments, as most instructions were not detailed enough to know what I was supposed to do for each step. After struggling through each assignment I was unsure which main objectives I completed or which skills I was supposed to gain. The midterm also felt unfair, in both its structure and grading.
- The topics for the course were great. We touched on a lot of the parts of the Blockchain. The bad part, as that there is not enough time for the instructor to completely teach each topic. Unfortunately, sometimes lectures were cut short.
- The course is slightly disorganized and cluttered, which makes it difficult to understand the material. However, the professor does his best to help his students anyway he can.
- The assignments are challenging sometimes due to it not being detailed enough which makes them take hours. I wish we had some sort of lab time where we could practice coding/skills while the professor was there. The class is also very short compared to all the things we have to learn which makes it a struggle to do the assignments since I feel like I don't have the resources. I wish the midterms/finals were more clear. The grading was pretty confusing on how it worked.
